The Mercyhurst Prep community is comprised of 425 students in grades 9–12 and 72 members of the faculty and support staff. The student-to-faculty ratio is 12:1, and 60% of the educational staff hold postgraduate degrees. The student body is diverse, with students from a range of ethnic, religious, and socioeconomic backgrounds. More than 65% of the student body received financial aid for the 2020–21 school year. More than \$1,200,000 was given in academic and financial aid.

THE MERCYHURST PREP DIFFERENCE

As a member of the 56-school Mercy Education System, we educate and develop the whole person by offering Lakers a customized curriculum that offers the best specific learning path for each student.

Mercyhurst Prep is a college preparatory school and the curriculum is rigorous, but students can customize their education from a wide range of program options. 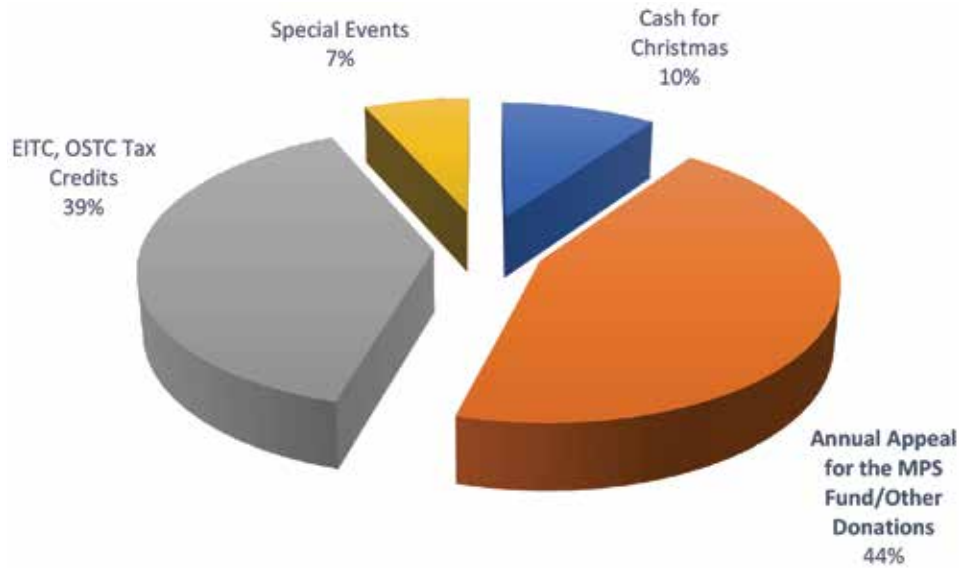
NEW SOCCER AND SOFTBALL FIELD
